Capital, District & Suburban Lineups Picked for the 37th Annual Capital Classic

American University to Host Game April 15th

Washington, D.C. (March 23, 2010) – Corrigan Sports Enterprises (CSE) and Sports America, Inc. announced today the Capital, District and Suburban rosters for the 37th Capital Classic and the District versus Suburban All-Stars preliminary game. Presented by Bart & Associates the annual high school boys basketball All-Star game, set for Wednesday, April 15, 2010 at American University, pits the nation's top prospects versus the D.C. area's elite seniors.

Headlining the lineup of 13 Capital All-Stars are Duke University bound **Josh Hairston** (F/6'8"/Montrose Christian) and **Tyler Thornton** (PG/6'2"/Gonzaga). Future Hoya **Markel Starks** (PG/6'2") will also figure prominently in the Capital All-Stars scoring after averaging 25 points and 8 assists for Georgetown Prep this year.

Of the 10 Capital All-Stars committed to play college basketball next year, five will be headed to either the Big East or Atlantic Coast Conference. In total 15 ACC or Big East recruits will take to the court to battle for the crown of longest running high school basketball All-Star contest in the country

The Capital All-Stars will be coached by **Louis Wilson** from Riverdale Baptist School. His career record stands at 465-185. Among his many accolades include his recent selection by the Prince George's County Gazette as the Coach of the Decade. He was named National Association of Christian Athletes (NACA) National Coach of the Year in 2005 after leading Riverdale Baptist High School to back-to-back national Christian School championships. Some of Coach Wilson's former players include Michael Beasley (Miami Heat/Kansas State), Don Reid (Detroit Pistons, Washington Wizards, Orlando Magic/Georgetown) and Nolan Smith (Duke).

From its prominent beginning in 1974, the Capital Classic has introduced fans to the next generation of superstars. The greats, including Moses Malone, Michael Jordan, Patrick Ewing, Magic Johnson and Dominique Wilkins have all participated in the Capital Classic, as well as the new age All-Stars of LeBron James, Chris Paul and Carmelo Anthony.

Tip-off for the Capital Classic is set for 8 p.m. and the game will be preceded by a 6 p.m. District versus Suburban game.
